I Corinthians 10:13

A STORY “I lusted after a woman.” John shared with his friend. He felt so guilty. He wanted forgiveness and wanted to know if he can ever have victory over this temptation. The friend shared that everyone of us face temptations, just as Adam and Eve in the Bible were tempted in three areas, Jesus was tempted in the wilderness by the devil in three areas. We are tempted usually in three areas.

DIGGING INTO THE BIBLE In I John 2:15-16 it gives us a look at the three. It reads “Love not the world neither the things that are in the world; the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes and the pride of life.” Someone summarized with these words: 1) The desire to indulge 2) The desire to possess 3) The desire to impress. These three are common temptations for everyone but especially for the new person seeking to make a commitment to follow Jesus. It is very important for each person in the journey to know
