I.2: My vision is unclear [Proverbs 29:18]

A STORY

Often as Joe was leading the ministry, he found himself unable to move in the right direction. He copied other ministry forms but always found himself empty with the results. One day he read Proverbs 29:18 and began to ponder how do I develop a vision or clarify where I am going.

DIGGING INTO THE SCRIPTURES

Let us look at **Proverbs 29:18:** "Where there is no vision the people perish." KJV

NOTE: All vision clarity is based on focus. We must have focus in our physical eyesight to see clearly. Likewise, in our spiritual vision we must have focus.

- 3. What does the word perish mean? What emotion do you feel when you think of perish?

- 3. What would one step be for you to move toward your vision today?



MORE DIGGING INTO THE BIBLE

Read Jeremiah 9:23,24:

It says "Let not the wise man boast of his wisdom or the strong man of his strength or the rich man of his riches, but let him who boast, boast of this, 'That he understands and knows me, that I am the Lord who exercises kindness, justice and righteousness on the earth, for in these I delight."

DISCOVERY AND DISCUSSION

- 1. What did you discover from this verse that people can get focused on (Boast of)?
- 2. What should we not boast in?
- 3. What should we boast in or focus on?
- 4. How will that focus change the way we see the vision that is on God's heart?
- 5. How does knowing God change our focus?

APPLICATION AND ACCOUNTABILITY

- 4. What does God want us to focus on?
- 5. What steps can you take to be sure you are focused on what is important to him?
- 6. How does that impact your present vision clarity?
- 7. What steps will you take to increase your clarity of vision?
